- 57 7 William Arey, s/o Gottlieb Arey, Sr, died Mar 1839, Silver Creek Twp, Greene Co, Ohio. Some branches of this family spell the name ARY and others use EARY.

The original consent and the marriage bond for William & Mary [Stowers] Arey have been located in Orange Co, Va (see attached Document). The consent was signed by Mary Stowers "Sr" while the marriage bond was signed by bondsmen William "Airy" [Sr] and Lewis Stowers and by witness James Taylor. (Delete note * on page 57). See also the addition below for Appendix IV (Stowers). Mary [Stowers] Arey was still alive on 6 Aug 1857 when she was named ("my Mother, Mary Ary") in the will of her son 7(f) William Jr in Greene Co, Oh.

A family researcher reports that deeds in Greene Co. Oh show the sale by some of his children of their 1/9 each share of the land of William Arey [Sr] (78 acres in Silvercreek Twp, part of the William Crogen Survey #3913). In 1840, William Arey [Jr] purchased from his sisters in Greene Co, Oh their shares as heirs of their father: Jabez Lucas & wife Elizabeth [Arey]; John Self & wife Nancy [Arey]; William Mullen & wife Fanny [Arey]; and Reuben Brackney (Brockney) & wife Sarah [Arey], one witness being their brother John Ary (Deed Bk 27, pp 146, 148). In 1846, Charles Ary and wife Roseanna sold some 38 acres of this survey to William Arey [Jr], they having purchased the 1/9 share of Christopher Vickery & wife Mary [Arey] in 1840 (Bk 27 pp 142, 143). They also sold on 13 Apr 1846 25 acres in

survey #3913 to their son-in-law Leonard Strong, who married in 1841 their daughter Mary Arey, witnesses David J. Devoe and William Stanton (Bk 24 p 323); and Charles & Rosanna Ary also sold 25 acres in this survey and the east ½ of 104 acres of survey #4675 in 1846 to John Brown, witnesses Joseph Mason and William Ary (Bk 24 pp 429, 461). In addition, on 17 May 1847, Charles & Rosannah Arey of Bureau Co, Ill sold for \$600 to their son Sinclair Arey of Greene Co, Oh approximately 53 acres of the Carter Page survey in Greene Co, Oh; son-in-law Leonard Strong was a witness (Bk 24 p 632). On 12 Sep 1845, an affidavit was filed (by Benjamin Strickler of Rockingham Co, Va) in a suit by 7(a) George Arey [of Rockingham Co, Va] for his share of the estate of his father, 7 William Arey Sr (Greene Co, Oh Deed Bk 24 pp 207-8).

In addition, Mitchel "Shifeley" (Shiflet) (who was to marry William Arey's granddaughter Maria Lucy Jane Arey, d/o Charles, some 4 months later) purchased one skillet and lid for 51¢.

She filed pension claim # 280,617 (declaration dated 2 Feb 1881, affidavit dated about 1883) as the mother of Wesley Ary who served in the CW. He enlisted at Princeton, Ill 19 Jul 1862 in Co. B, 64th Regt., Ill. Volunteer Infantry, and was shot dead at the Battle of Corinth, Miss, the ball passing through his head. His brothers Ryan and Nathaniel were in the same Company, and brother Ezra enlisted in 1864 in Co. I of the 64th.

By the will, William "Ary" Jr left household goods and kitchen furniture, a carriage, a buggy and choice of horses and the income from \$1,000 to his beloved wife Sally Ary. Son Joel Ary was to receive the residence and all the land of his father, including (if he wished to buy it from the other heirs at a fair price) the "Mullen" farm (lately

purchased from Silas Roberts) except for 25 acres of the Mullen farm on Hussy Road. Son Joel was to support "my Mother Mary Ary and wife Sally Ary". Wife Sally was to be provided with a separate house if she so desired, or support for living with any of her children. Daughter Eliza "Kline" (Cline) was to receive 25 acres of the Mullen farm on Hussy Road. Niece Minerva Mullin [d/o 7(i) Fanny [Arey] & William Mullen] was to receive \$50. The residual estate was left to his children, including the \$1,000 after his wife's death. (Wife Sally [Bayliff] Arey was the mother of the children.)

The first wife of Joel Arey, ?Eliza Mullen, was probably a sister of his second wife and thus also a daughter of William & Fanny [Arey] Mullen.

Appendix IV (Stowers) p 5, bottom: In Orange Co, Va on 24 Apr 1783, Anne and Patty Stowers were bound out by the Church Wardens; and also on 22 May 1783, Duke Stowers, a Poor Boy, s/o James Stowers, was similarly bound. It is possible that Anne, Patty, and Duke (as well as our ancestor Mary Stowers who married William Arey Sr) were all the children of the widow Mary [--] Stowers and her possible husband James Stowers who had died before 1783. However, James Stowers has not been further identified.
